Competition Update

March 6-8 our studio will be participating in the Star Talent Productions dance competition. This is a great opportunity for the dancers to experience performing and interacting with other dance studios. It is a very positive experience and all of the dancers are rewarded for their hard work. They will each receive a token for their participation.

The competition will be held in Louisburg at the Louisburg College Auditorium. Groups 1-10 (combo classes) will each take one of their routines (jazz or ballet). Groups A-H will take jazz and lyrical. Tap 3-4 and Hip Hop 1-4 A-C will also compete. The extra classes for combo (lyrical and hip hop) will not compete. In addition, Tap 1& 2 will not compete, as well as groups a-e (age 3/4 and 4/5 classes).

All dancers who will be participating will pay competition fees of \$50 per routine. For example, if you are in 3 routines, then your competition fees will be \$150. You should have received a total due in your December statement. All competition fees are due by January 15, 2020.

It is important for all dancers to be present in class between now and the competition time. We will be putting the final touches on our routines. It's hard to keep up if you are out. Please make every effort to be present and remember to email if you must be absent.

We will give you more information about the competition as soon as possible. We do not get the final schedule until about a week before the competition. Keep working hard. The routines are looking fabulous!

Music

As we approach competition and recital time, it is important to practice at home. With this in mind we will be putting together CD's with music for every routine. These CD's will be available for purchase at the front desk for \$5 each. All of your child's music will be on one CD, so you will only need to purchase one. We will let you know as soon as these CD's are available. Look for a sign in the lobby!



Policy Reminders

- ◆ The ballet instructors would like to remind you that proper dance attire is required for ballet class. You should wear a leotard with tights and pink ballet shoes. Boys should wear shorts with a fitted shirt and black ballet shoes. Please no baggy or extra clothing. Also your hair should be pulled back and secured in a bun. If your hair is too short for a bun, please pull it back and secure it the best way possible.
- ◆ Cell phones have become a major distraction. We understand the need for them as a safety precaution, but please do not bring them into the classrooms. Turn the ringers off and leave them in your dance bags. We do not want anything to distract from the instruction. We have such a short time and with competition fast approaching we need everyone to be focused!
- ◆ Parents, please do not drop your children off more than 10 minutes before class begins and pick them up promptly when class is over. All students should wait in the lobby or under the awning for their rides to arrive. Only those students who drive themselves should be in the parking lot without an adult. If your dancer has a break between classes and needs to wait at the studio, they should wait in the dressing room or the lobby and bring homework or something else to do.

Thank you for your cooperation and attention to these matters. We need everyone to work together to make our dance studio the best that it can be!

Important Info and Reminders

- You may pay your tuition when we return to class the week of January 6th. Payments will not be considered late until after January 9th.
- REMINDER: Costumes are going to be distributed the first week of February. You must have all balances paid in full in order to receive your costumes. **All balances must be paid by January 31st.** Please see your monthly statement for the total due.
- There will be a list of all the dancer's names posted in the lobby during the month of January. Please check the list and make sure that your child's name is spelled correctly. This is how it will appear in the recital program and on the recital t-shirt. (Deadline January 31st.)
- Please remember to wear the proper dance clothes and shoes to class. If you are not sure what shoes you should wear, please ask your instructor.
- Always check the bulletin board for important information. Announcements are posted on the door as well.
- The monthly newsletter will always be posted on the bulletin board in the lobby and on the website.
- Write your dancer's name on all dance gear (shoes, bag, jacket, etc.). If something is lost the "lost and found" is located in the dressing room.
- The Dance Attic will be closed for the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday on Monday, January 20th. Enjoy the day off!
- Go ahead and post these important dates on your calendars.
